Approval of Minutes from Regular Meeting: May 22, 2019 (Peters, Esparza, carries)

President's Report – **Mark Vespoli** – The tax rolls have been updated. Garages are now excluded and a commerical property has been converted to a residential property.

- Recommend Sponsorship of 4th of July Parade Fun Run at a cost not to exceed \$1,000 - The race starts and ends on Vernon Street and benefits Crime Stoppers. The number of participants has doubled (Peters, Hazen, carries)
- Recommend supplementing budget for sign project by an additional \$5,000 The quote from Ellis & Ellis was inaccurate. After discussion, it was decided that \$2,000 would be a sufficient supplement to the current budget for this proejct (Esparza, Louthan, carries)

New Discussions:

- Placer Visitors Bureau presentation Rob Haswell, Executive Director – Funded by Placer County Economic Development and charged with promoting all of Placer County. They are working on new branding. Haswell says there is a feeling of disconnect with South Placer County - he is looking for board members to represent the Roseville area on the Bureau.
- New Projects Discussion
 - Lights Maudru researched the installation of lights in downtown Auburn and found contact information that the Cap Improvements team will follow up on. Louthan said that there will be issues to address such as liability, light placement; power sources and more.
 - Facades Grants a meeting will be set up with city representatives. The board and the city will look over an older facade program, assess if and how the DRP can be involved and revise the program to suit current needs and financial availability.
 - Alley Clean up Project Esparza and Carlson will identify what can be done and organize volunteer groups (scouts, etc).
 - A 2020 Mural Program it was agreed that the mural program was a great sucess and should be continued next year.
