Program Aides (Part-Time, Seasonal)

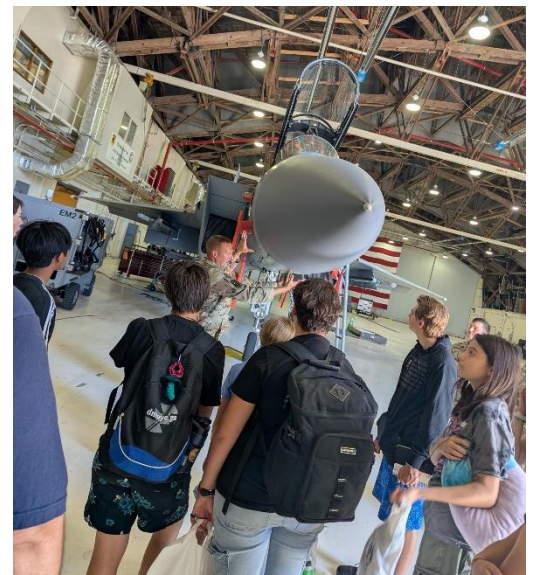
