**What Services are rendered by your organization?**

Placer SPCA provides a comprehensive continuum of care designed to improve animal welfare and support pet-owning families across the community. Core services include safe sheltering, medical treatment, and behavioral support for homeless and at-risk animals; adoption programs that place animals into permanent, loving homes; and accessible veterinary and preventative care, including low-cost vaccinations, spay/neuter services, and microchipping. To reduce shelter intake and keep pets with their families, Placer SPCA offers pet retention services such as pet food assistance, behavioral guidance, and resource referrals. The organization also delivers humane education programs that foster compassion and responsible pet ownership, while engaging volunteers and foster families to expand capacity and enhance outcomes. Together, these integrated services address both immediate needs and long-term solutions, creating a more humane and sustainable community for animals and people alike.

**How will the Donation be used?**

Proceeds from Woof, Wine & Dine directly support Placer SPCA's life-saving programs and critical services for animals and the community. Funds raised help provide daily care for shelter animals, including food, enrichment, and safe housing, as well as essential medical treatment such as vaccinations, spay/neuter surgeries, and care for injured or at-risk animals. Donations also expand access to low-cost veterinary services and pet retention programs—like pet food assistance and behavioral support—that help families keep their pets and prevent unnecessary surrender.
