Talent Show Rules & Guidelines

- 1. Family-Friendly Content:** All performances must be appropriate for a general audience. Acts containing explicit language, offensive gestures, or inappropriate material will be disqualified.
- 2. Music Requirement:** All music used in performances must be clean — free of profanity, explicit content, or suggestive themes.
- 3. Time Limit:** Acts must not exceed 5 minutes in length unless previously approved by the organizers.
- 4. Equipment:** Performers are responsible for bringing their own instruments, props, and special equipment unless otherwise arranged.
- 5. Punctuality:** All participants must check in at least 30 minutes before showtime. Late arrivals may forfeit their slot.
- 6. Safety First:** Acts involving dangerous stunts, fire, or sharp objects must receive prior written approval from event coordinators.
- 7. Respect & Sportsmanship:** Participants are expected to treat fellow contestants, judges, and staff with kindness and respect.
