 - Cash rewards for information leading to arrests or case resolutions in serious crimes committed in Roseville
 - Scholarships for Roseville youth pursuing careers in public safety
 - Community education, including distributing public-safety materials at events and hosting forums on current crime and safety trends

What services are rendered by your organization?

Roseville Community Crime Stoppers is a community-driven nonprofit that supports public safety in Roseville by helping prevent and solve crime. We raise funds to assist the Roseville Police Department and strengthen partnerships between residents and law enforcement.

A key part of our work is providing anonymous tip reporting. Community members can share information about crimes through an online portal, a mobile app, or by calling 916-783-STOP. Tipsters remain anonymous and may be eligible for a reward.

Our mission focuses on community involvement, public education, and building positive relationships with public safety organizations to improve the overall quality of life in Roseville. We also host events such as Run Crime Out of Roseville to raise awareness and support our programs.

How will the donation be used?
