WHERE IS THE PRAIRIE ROCK TRAILS BIKE PARK LOCATED?

The bike park is located at 1500 Elm Drive in Mason City, Iowa.

WHERE SHOULD I PARK?

Event parking will be available near the bike park and surrounding trailhead areas.

Attendees are encouraged to follow posted event signage and allow extra time during peak hours.

DO I NEED TO REGISTER?

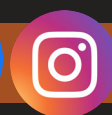
