Set within a 560-acre city park surrounding a 200-acre lake on the northern edge of Paola, Lake Miola offers exceptional boating, fishing, camping, and beachside recreation for outdoor enthusiasts year-round.

PARK ATTRACTIONS & OUTDOOR FEATURES

Boating & Water Sports

200-acre lake with accessible boat ramps for motorboats, jet skis, kayaks, and paddleboards. Popular for water skiing and tube towing.

Fishing Access

Well-stocked waters with largemouth bass, channel/flathead catfish, crappie, and bluegill. Bank fishing docks and open-water boat access available.

Swimming Beach & Volleyball

Designated sandy beach area for daylight swimming and sunbathing, alongside adjacent sand volleyball courts.

Campgrounds & RV Facilities

Offers primitive tent sites, electric hookups, and sewer pads. Includes on-site shower house, dump station, and seasonal camp host.

Trails & Picnic Areas

Scenic paths for walking and biking, dog park area, playgrounds, and shaded picnic tables with grills.

CONSERVATION & BOATING RULES

Zebra Mussel Alert: Clean, drain, and dry all watercraft before entering or leaving the lake to prevent invasive species spread. Boating & fishing permits required.

Open April 1 through October 31.

- Electrical Hookup: \$20.00/day
- Sewer Hookup: \$22.00/day
