

Summer Critter Camp Junior Counselor Application Application Deadline is April 21st, 2023

Having helpful Junior Counselors makes Rescue Ranch Critter Camp possible. Without the support of these dedicated individuals our program could not exist. We depend on a close ratio of campers to teachers and Junior Counselors in order to ensure a safe and fun environment for everyone. Many campers and Junior Counselors return year after year to reconnect with old friends and form new and lasting bonds.

The Junior Counselor program is both fun and hard work. Junior Counselors should enjoy working with children, be able to demonstrate a respect for animals, serve as a positive role model for campers, and provide dependable, responsible support for staff and campers. Space in the program is limited, unfortunately, and we regret that we are unable to accept every applicant. Please note that camp Junior Counselors must be entering at least 7th grade in the fall of 2023 and between 12-17 years old.

Returning Junior Counselors only need to fill out the application, submit the application fee, and attend one of the training dates. The interview, essay, and letter of recommendation are not required for those returning for their second year or more as a junior Counselor.

Junior Counselor Responsibilities:

- Junior Counselors act as teacher assistants during our Critter Camp.
- They perform a variety of duties including set-up and cleanup, participation during crafts and games, helping with animal presentations, assisting with managing children's behavior, and supervising snack and lunch times.
- It is important to understand that the Junior Counselor's main responsibility is working with children and not the animals.

Time Requirements:

Junior Counselors are required to work for an entire week. No partial weeks accepted. Junior Counselors can work for more than one week if desired, provided there is room.

- 1.) The Exceptional Children's camp Junior Counselor shift is Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 12:30pm OR 12:30pm to 4:30pm.
- 2.) Preschool camp is Monday Thursday 8:30am 12:30pm OR 12:30pm to 4:30pm.
- 3.) The elementary and middle school camp Junior Counselor shifts are Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 4:30pm.

Interview and Training Sessions:

- Junior Counselors will be contacted to participate in a group interview.
- Successful applicants will then be required to attend a training session.
- To be consistent in providing a safe and quality camp experience and to be fair to all Junior Counselors, we will not make exceptions





- 1) Complete and return the 2023 Critter Camp Junior Counselor Application. We can only accommodate a limited number of Junior Counselors each week. **Week preferences are granted on a first come, first served basis.** The application deadline is April 21st, 2023.
- 2) <u>Scheduling</u>: Please give us at least three options of Junior Counselor workweek choices. Due to the challenges of scheduling so many Junior Counselors if you have only one week available your chance of getting a spot is significantly diminished. Transportation is your responsibility. We consider schedule requests for carpool reasons, but there are no guarantees. Friends are not placed in the same class. EC Camp assignments are limited to return counselors only; spots are limited so make sure to make multiple selections of camp preferences.
- 3) **Essay**: Applicants must complete these questions on a separate sheet of paper (One paragraph each):

Question 1. What do you hope to get out of this experience?

Question 2. Why should we select you?

- 4) <u>Letter of Recommendation</u>: Applicants must have one letter of recommendation from an unrelated adult. This could be a teacher, coach, scout leader, etc.
- 5) <u>Application Fee:</u> The application fee is \$25. This fee covers your t-shirt and training. This fee can be mailed in with your application or turned in on your interview day. We can accept cash or check only.
- 6) We will email you to verify that we have received your application. If you do not receive a confirmation within one week of sending your application, please email education@rescueranch.com to inquire. Please be sure to add rescueranch.com to your allowed email lists so it doesn't end up in your SPAM folder.
- 7) <u>New Applicant Interviews</u>: You will be emailed your group interview date and time. It is your responsibility to contact the Humane Education Manager if you have not received your interview time by **May 1st**. All new applicants must attend an interview.
- 8) <u>Training Sessions</u>: Training is required for all Junior Counselors. If you are selected to be a Junior Counselor for summer 2023 Critter Camps, you will receive an email with your training session time by **May 10th**. If you are not selected, you will receive an email and will not need to attend training. If you don't receive an email please contact Jennifer at education@rescueranch.com to inquire.
- 9) <u>Week Assignments</u>: Workweek assignments will be emailed by **May 24th**. If you do not receive an email please contact Jennifer at <u>education@rescueranch.com</u> to inquire. Your Junior Counselor assignment will be canceled if you do not attend a training session.
