



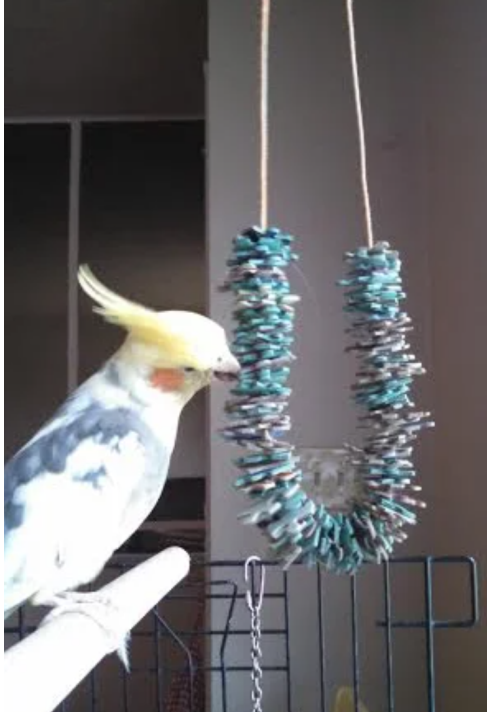
## DIY Animal Enrichment

**Notes:** These are great options for the birds! They provide color in their enclosures and gives them something to shred. These can also be made with decks of cards!

## Cardboard Scratch Mat

**Notes:** Make sure that there is no tape or staples on any of the pieces of cardboard that are being used! These scratch mats are great for exploring and foraging.





Give your bunny something to dig her claws into. She'll love scratching away at this pad.

**You need: CARDBOARD BOX & SCISSORS**

Cut the flaps off of the box. Then cut the sides down to about 1.5" high.

Measure the width of the box. Cut the discarded cardboard into stripes of that length and 1.5" high. They'll fit snugly into the box.

Fill the box completely with cardboard stripes, you may need more cardboard.

Let the little rascal claw away.
