

2023 Youth Classes Fall

Class 1: INTRO: Go over machine, safety, cleaning, Sewing Tool Kit Basics, Glossary, Test out machine.

*Please bring to class: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle and the manual. We will be checking out the machines and if there is a problem, we have an in-house repair center. You can leave the machine and it will be ready for the next class. General cleaning, adjusting, lubricating service is \$75. Parts needed are extra and we would discuss that with you. We also have classroom machines which can be used.

*Basic sewing kit which includes: Extra bobbins, needles, fabric marking pen or pencil, sewing clips or pins, tweezers, scissors for clipping threads, shears and a seam ripper. If you do not have all of these for the first class, do not worry about it. We will be discussing these and they will be used for future classes.

*Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

Class 2: Coasters: 10- 5" squares, Coordinating or contrasting for each coaster. We'll make 2. **Fabric Tray:** 2- 10" Squares and 1- 10" batting for each tray.

Class 3: Easy Table Runner: 2 fabrics Theme Print: 10"-12" (1/3 yard) of theme print, width of fabric (WOF). Coordinating Fabric: 18" (1/2 yard) of coordinating fabric for back/border (WOF).

Class 4: Apron 1 yard fabric. A second fabric can be used if you wish to have pockets or ties contrast with the focus fabric used for the apron.

Class 5: Traveling Totes 2- Contrasting FQ, drawstring

Bonus Class 6: Finish any unfinished project.

. 9×12" pieces wool felt: 3 of red,

1 each of turquoise and yellow

- Fine-point marker
- Clear template plastic
- Scissors
- Sewing machine
- Embroidery floss to match wool felt pieces
- Embroidery needle
- Use a 1/2 " seam allowance unless otherwise stated.
