


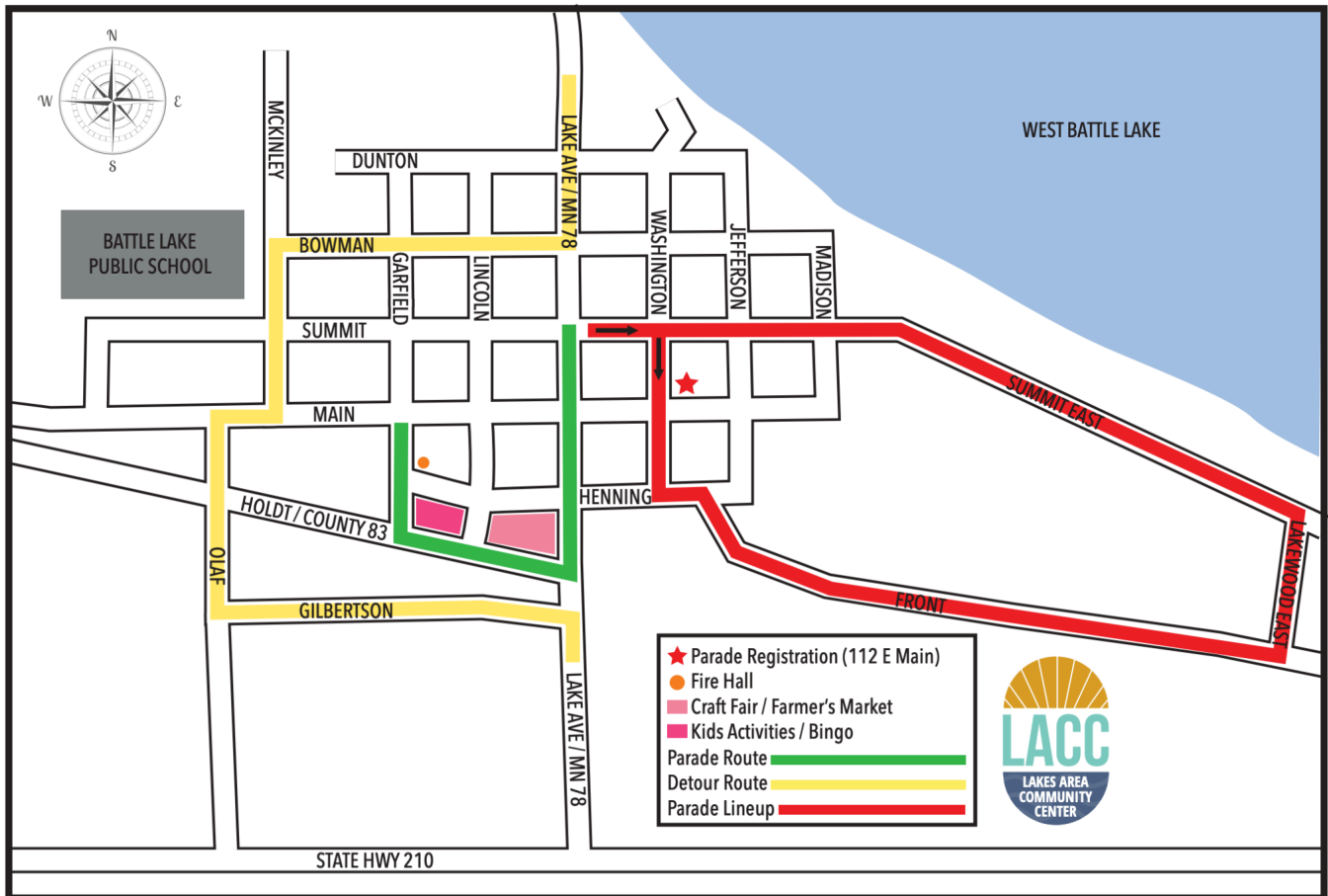
2025 Wenonga Days Parade – Participant FAQ

Check-In & Line-Up Instructions

- Check-in Time: 5:00 – 6:30 PM (prior to parade start)
- Check-in Location: *Washington Ave in front of Lakes Country on Main (behind 1st National Bank)*
- Once checked in, proceed to Front Street to find your assigned spot.
- Traffic flows one-way during line-up. Look for your number posted on the side of the street.

Line-Up Tips

- If riders are meeting you, arrive together as one unit.
 - Do not drop people off in the line-up area—there is no parking for non-parade vehicles.
 - Suggested meeting location: Battle Lake School parking lot.

Parade Rules & Reminders

- Keep it Family Friendly. No inappropriate signage, props, or decorations. Units may be removed at organizers' discretion.
 - Candy Safety
 -  Do not throw candy at intersections: Summit & Hwy 78 or Hwy 78 & Hwy 83
 -  Instead, hand candy directly to spectators.
 - No Confetti or Litter**
Avoid items that are hard to clean and may blow into yards.
 - Maintain Spacing**
 -  Keep 50–100 feet between your unit and the one ahead.
 - Do not stop for walkers to catch up unless directed.
 - Animal Units**
 -  Must have their own clean-up crew following immediately behind.
 - Right to Deny**
Parade organizers reserve the right to accept or deny entries for any reason.
