July 4 is rapidly approaching, are you ready for some good eating? Are you bar-b-que ribs, hamburgers, steaks, or classic hot dogs kind of person? If you need a side dish to go with your favorite, Twisted Pasta Salad might become a new July 4th favorite. Shirley Bry's submission in the 1990 Todd Valley Friendship Club Potluck Recipes cookbook has been a long time favorite in the Foresthill community.

- 4 quarts Water
- 2 cups dry Pasta Twists
- 2 tablespoons Almonds
- ¼ cup cooked chopped Bacon
- 1/3 cup Mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon Honey
- ¼ teaspoon Pepper
- ½ cup finely chopped Celery
- ½ cup shredded Carrots
- 1 Green Onion, sliced

In large pot bring water to boiling, stir in pasta and cook until tender. Now drain pasta, rinse in cold water until pasta is cool, then drain again. In a skillet, cook almonds until golden brown, remove and save till later, Next cook bacon, drain and chop to get a ¼ cup. In a large bowl, combine mayonnaise, honey, and pepper. Add pasta, bacon, celery, carrots and onion. Stir to coat with dressing. Sprinkle with toasted almonds. Serves 4-6
