- December 2025 completion date






Tradd Street Sink Hole

Kimbrough Park Update



- Playground installation should be completed by the end of the week.
- Coordinating a maintenance agreement with Foster Lake and Pond Management to begin treating and cleaning Kimbrough and all other ponds on park property.
- Awaiting the arrival of the kit for the new picnic shelter and will contract installation when we have an official ship date.
- Upon completion of the shelter, the sidewalk will be repaired and extended from the parking area to the new shelter.



Public Works Update

- Resurfacing of streets is almost complete. The contractor will begin to resurface greenways soon.
- The Water and Meeting Street project is complete.
- Alexander and Stockton Street sidewalk project should begin in 2 weeks.




Three week look ahead on street closures
