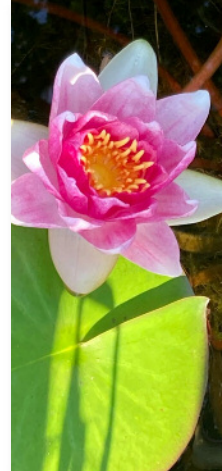
Title "The Lonely Path Ahead"

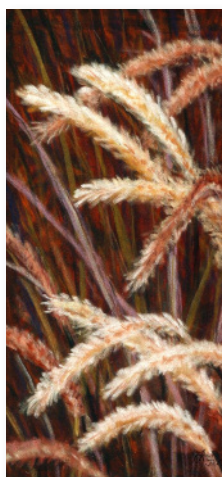
