Do you want to build a snowman?

The Snowman Stroll is a winter tradition presented by the Rock Springs Main Street/URA in partnership with the Community Fine Arts Center. Born out of a simple idea—how can we better embrace winter in Rock Springs?—the project brings color, creativity, and fun to Downtown during the coldest and often dreariest months of the year.

Standing 48 inches tall, snowmen painted by local artists will brighten the streets from late January through early March, inviting the community to take a Snowman Stroll. Alongside the public art, we're creating family-friendly activities to make the experience even more engaging.

The snowmen are stored during the off-season and return year after year, with new additions expected annually. Over time, the Stroll will grow into a dynamic, family-friendly tradition that residents and visitors alike look forward to every winter.

Where Will The Snowmen be placed?

The snowmen will be placed throughout Downtown Rock Springs.

Who Will See The Snowmen?

While our primary audience will be locals, we anticipate attracting folks from the surrounding areas as well, particularly as more and more snowmen are added each year.

Who Manages the Snowmen?

The Rock Springs Main Street/Urban Renewal Agency manages the snowmen.

Call to Artists Deadline

The Rock Springs Main Street/Urban Renewal Agency (URA) is accepting applications now through October 15, 2025 from artists who wish to participate in the Snowman Stroll. Artists will have November through January 12, 2026 to prep and paint their snowmen.

Each artist whose design is selected for exhibition will be provided with a life-size, blank fiberglass snowman form and will be paid a \$500 honorarium upon completion and approval of their painted snowman.

Eligibility

The Snowman Stroll is open to all artists, from the acclaimed to the amateur. Painters, sculptors, craftsmen, multi-media artists, and other wildly creative people are all encouraged to apply.



What You Need To Do

Send in an original and two (2) copies of each of the following:

- ✓ Completed application form
- ✓ Your proposed design(s)
- ✓ A brief statement about your design
- ✓ Photos, slides or other examples of your past work
- ✓ Signed Copyright Assignment to:

Important

You must submit an ORIGINAL signed Copyright Assignment as part of your application. The additional two copies may be photocopies. The Snowman Stroll is unable to return any materials submitted.

Please restrict all material submitted to no larger than 8.5" x 11" in size.

All material submitted as part of the application will become the property of the Rock Springs Main Street/Urban Renewal Agency (URA) and the Community Fine Arts Center and will not be returned to the artist.

Artists may submit your design for consideration. You may submit more than one design if you choose to paint more than one snowman. They may be mailed together; however, please provide the required number of copies of each application element, including an ORIGINAL signed Copyright Assignment for each design proposal.

Timeline

The Snowman Stroll committee will review your application as soon as it is submitted to ensure that it complies with the guidelines. If approved, your design will become part of the portfolio shown to event sponsors.

We encourage artists to submit proposals as soon as possible so that we can assemble a sizeable and diverse portfolio for review by sponsors and because sponsors will be matched with artists as they join the event. We will notify you when your artist application has been received.

Depending on the number of artist submissions, not all artists will be selected. Artists WILL BE notified when they are partnered with a sponsor. This will take some time so please be patient. Follow the Rock Springs Main Street/Urban Renewal Agency (URA) on social media for updates and details. Please feel free to contact us to check on the status of the sponsor selection process.



APPLICATION SUBMISSIONS

Artists will be notified no later than October 24, 2025 on the status of their application.

The Details

Snowman Specifications: 48" high by 24" D (bottom ball)

The snowmen are manufactured using fiberglass. The artist may alter the basic poses, so long as they remain structurally intact. Each snowman arrives with a coat of primer applied by the manufacturer.

Paints, Topcoats and Weatherproofing

Snowmen will be placed in areas fully accessible to the public, mostly likely outdoors. In creating a design, please consider carefully the weather and other elements of nature, including sun, snow/rain, wind and dirt.

We cannot guarantee placement of a given snowman in any particular location.

Additionally, the Snowman Stroll is an interactive event that allows the public to touch and feel the designs. As such, designs should be created with durability and public safety concerns in mind. Although objects may be attached to the snowmen, artists should be aware that vandalism can and unfortunately does occur. Any object added to a snowman should be attached in such a way that it cannot be easily removed.

The surface of each snowman is primed by the manufacturer. Unless you have altered the pose or exterior of your snowman, you will not need to reapply a primer. Acrylic paint, artificial resin paint or two component paint can be used to paint the snowmen.

A minimum of three coats of varnish is required using a two-part, hard gloss varnish. This step is critical to the ultimate durability of your snowman, and snowmen which are returned unvarnished or which are incorrectly varnished may not be exhibited.

When placed in public, the snowmen may be affixed to additional bases.

Installation and Repair of Snowmen

Artists will not be responsible for the installation or removal of the snowmen, as the Rock Springs Main Street/URA and Community Fine Arts Center will manage this process. Artists should, however, be available for any possible touch-up work that may be required once the exhibit is underway.



Design Guidelines

Artists should bear in mind that the audience will be broad-based and of all ages, and designs should be appropriate for public display. Designs that are religious, political or sexual in nature will not be accepted. Additionally, neither corporate logos nor advertising is allowed. (Sponsors of each snowman will be recognized on the base by the Rock Springs Main Street/URA. While this area can be painted, please note that a sign will be placed on the base.) As outlined below, designs will be evaluated to ensure they conform to these guidelines. The Rock Springs Main Street/URA may reject any design that, in its sole discretion, does not adhere to these guidelines.

For the 2026 Stroll, one of our sponsors has expressed particular interest in a snowman design featuring a bison or a herd of bison. Artists with skills or experience in creating wildlife imagery—especially bison—are strongly encouraged to apply.

Rights/Entitlements

By submitting your application, you confirm that:

- 1. You are the original creator of your design.
- 2. You have not copied anyone else's original work.
- 3. Your design does not infringe on anyone else's intellectual property rights (for example, trademark, copyrights, trade dress, design patent).
- 4. To the extent anyone else has contributed to your design, you shall obtain a signed, written agreement from that person assigning all of their rights in their contribution to you.

As part of the application process, you must sign the "Copyright Assignment" that accompanies this application. By signing, dating and returning the original Copyright Assignment with your application, you are indicating your understanding that you are assigning the entire right, title and interest to your design to the Rock Springs Main Street/URA, the organizers of the art exhibition. Please remember to keep a copy of these forms for your records.

If your finished snowman is approved for exhibition, you will receive a \$500 honorarium. The Rock Springs Main Street/URA will continue to own the entire right, title and interest in your design proposal, accompanying sketches and all derivative works, including the final work completed on the fiberglass snowman. You will be acknowledged as the artist on a plaque attached to the base of the snowman and in appropriate publications and promotions. However, the copyrights, including the rights to reproduce your design, create copies or reprint your design in books, will be owned by the Rock Springs Main Street/URA.

If your design is not approved or selected for exhibition, the Rock Springs Main Street/URA shall assign the entire right, title and interest in your design back to you.
