Police Department Expansion Construction Update







A crane will be set up the week of September 15, 2025, with pre-cast concrete deliveries beginning September 22. Deliveries will be offloaded from Front Street first before moving to Tradd Street. While this may create some additional congestion, impacts are expected to be minimal since streets in the area are already closed.

Police Department Expansion: Storm drain installation has started along Front Street, and demolition at the Police Department building is also underway, including removal of the lower-level awning and basement entrance, as well as modifications to the interior handicapped ramp to accommodate construction.



Airport Terminal Building Construction Update




- 3rd Floor Balcony roof is complete

- Coordinating between CBL and DELCO to complete the project.





Fire Station 5 Project Update


- We received 150 applications for the 15 open positions. 100 will sit for the written test tomorrow.

- SFD is working with Engineering to develop a site plan and estimate costs for house reno.






New Vehicle Maintenance Garage in Action Staff thanked City Council for providing the great space to work

Kimbrough Park Update




- Playground installation is complete.

- A PO has been issued for the fence/wall work at the Flats. Work should begin soon.


