

Highway 36 Treasure Hunt Seneca, Kansas September 18-20, 2025



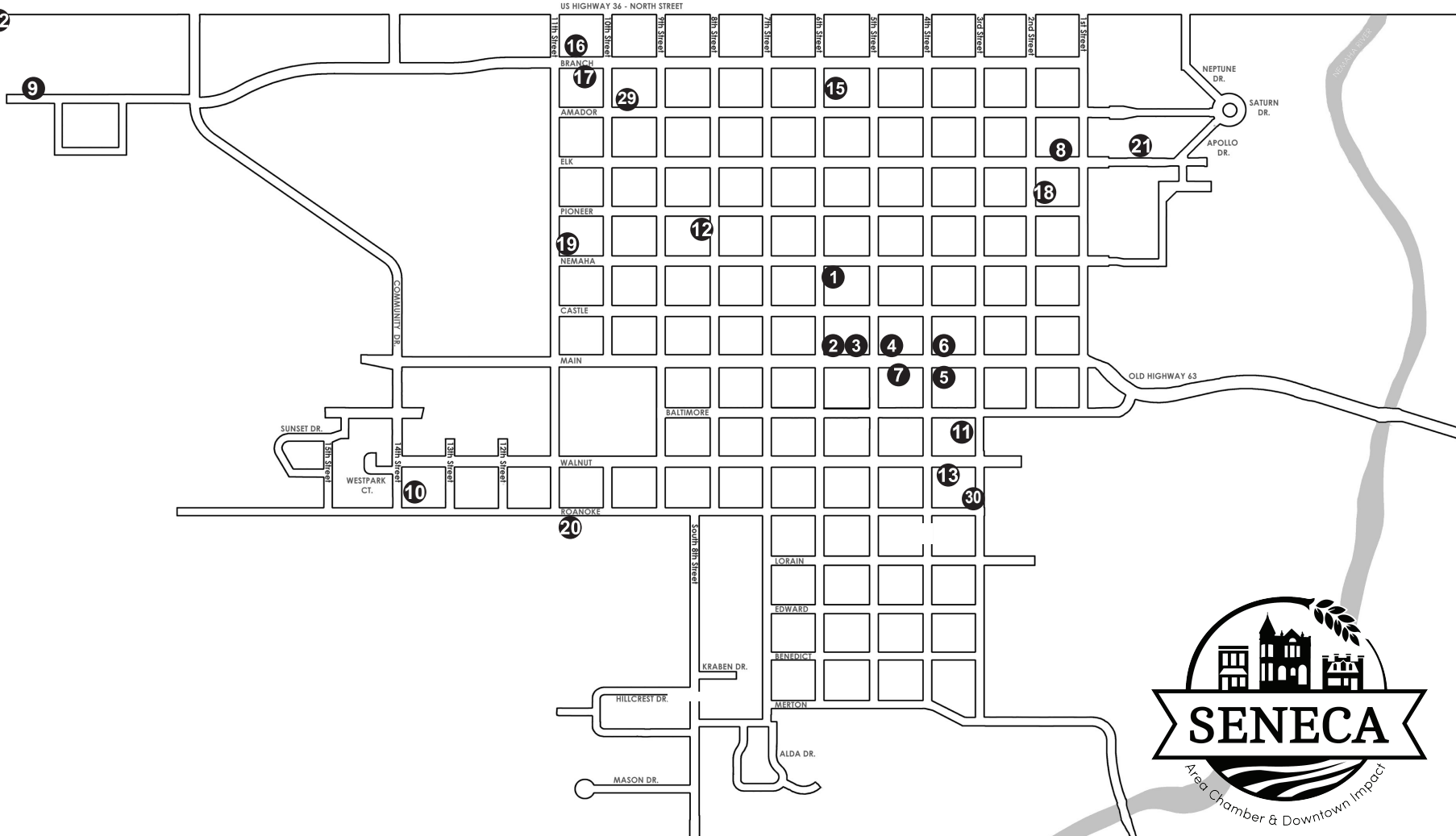
#14 is located 2 miles north on Hwy 63, then .8 miles back east on 168th Road.

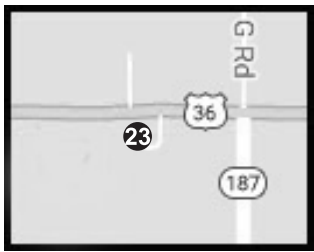
#25 is located 10 miles east of Seneca.

#24 is located 3 miles north of Highway 36 in St. Benedict



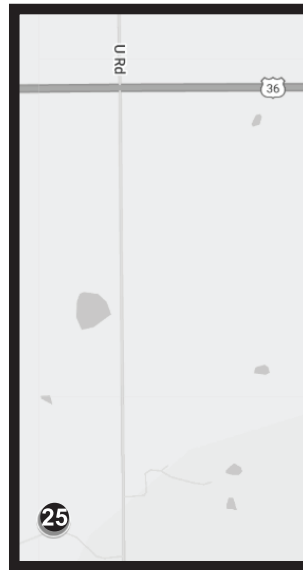
#23 is located 3 miles west of Seneca

(see backside of Map)



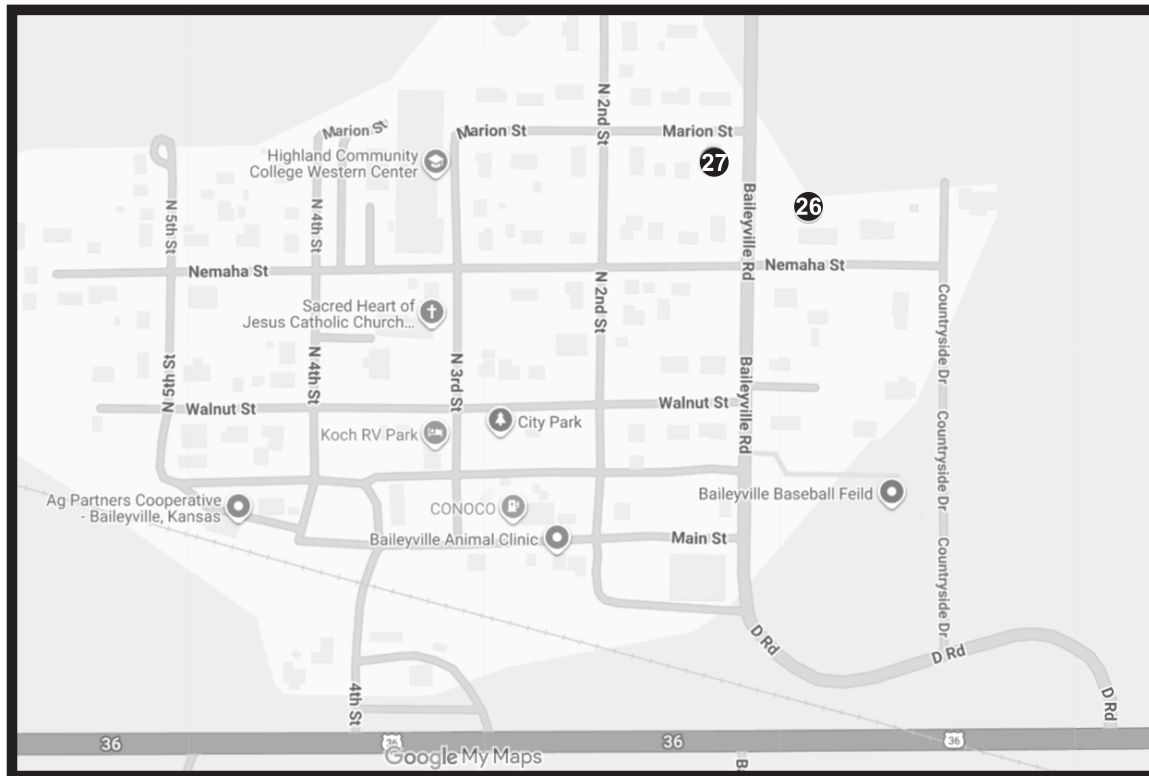


#23 is located 3 miles west of Seneca on Highway 36
