- Mural Location #3 Goldfields: MDRP permit is under review.
- Mural Location #4 City of Roseville CMU behind Goldfields: Blue Line is reviewing city attorney's feedback and will continue to discuss with city stakeholders.
- Mural Location #5 Blue Line Arts: will be promoting the DRP match for up to \$15,000 for Artist Commissions for their front facade during the upcoming Gallery Gala Benefit Art Auction fundraiser on October 4th.
- Mural Location #6: 246 Vernon Street (faded mural between Westhouse and Lucas & Co salon originally painted by artist Juanishi Orosco) this property is currently owned by Kirk Doyle however he is currently in the process of selling this property. He has agreed to pass along Blue Line Arts contact information to the new buyer to see if they are interested.
