



# Police Department Expansion Construction Update

#### **Parking Garage**

- The current plan is to have the crane operation completed by the end of November.
- After the crane is moved, DELCO will start on storm drain install on Tradd Street, which should allow Tradd Street to be open by mid-December.
- Substantial completion for the Parking Garage is currently estimated at 3/31/26.

#### **PD Expansion**

- Post tension slab and slab on grade preparation to start next week.
- DELCO plans to start on the interior renovation of the PD the week of 11/17/25.
- Substantial Completion for the PD Expansion is currently estimated at 8/28/26.



# Kimbrough Park Update




- Playground installation is complete.

# **Public Works Update**


- The sidewalk project (Alexander and Stockton) walkthrough is scheduled for this week. Construction hopefully starting within the next 2 weeks.
- Fence/wall work at the Flats have been delayed due to soft soil.






# Waterline Spline Update

- Construction has finished in the Water Street area and has now progressed along Stockton Street to Brevard Street.
- Crews have also completed the interstate crossing, which is now in place and ready for connection to both the Water Treatment Plant extension and the Carolina Avenue connection.
- Pipe installation has passed Iredell Memorial Hospital and continues southward along Brookdale Drive.
- To date, the city has submitted for and received reimbursement of \$2,957,173, representing 14.8% of the project's total \$20 million in grant funding.





# South Yadkin Pump Station

- Pumps have been installed
- Startup testing is scheduled for early November, when crews will run the new pumps to ensure everything is operating as designed.
- Once the pump validation process is successfully completed, the project will reach substantial completion – meaning the new station will be fully functional and ready to our secondary water supply.

# Infill Development

- Since 2020 there have been roughly 425 new single family residential houses/buildings – equivalent to a large subdivision
- Total value for those PERMITS was \$68.5M or \$161,000/permit
- Additional yearly revenue from these homes = \$355,000
- Four multi-family buildings w/tax value of \$17M over same time
- Additional yearly revenue from these buildings = \$88,250






