



STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION WITHIN THE CITY OF STATESVILLE

WHEREAS, Winter Storm Gianna has the potential to create hazardous conditions including winter precipitation and ice; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described emergency I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the City of Statesville under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Article III, Chapter 14-51, Ordinance 2003-03 of the Statesville Code of Ordinances:

Section 1. A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of the City of Statesville

Section 2. I hereby order all city law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the City of Statesville Emergency Operations Plan.

Section 3. I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with Clerk and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

Section 4. This declaration shall take effect on January 30, 2026 at 5:00 PM, and shall remain in effect until February 5, 2026 at 5:00 PM.
